Senator Peris asked:

Mr Brown: Correct. We have also seen in both greenfields and brownfields one of our most extensive delays in the country. Only recently have we actually achieved the 2,700 brownfields pass numbers. Those numbers have only occurred since July.

Senator LUNDY: So that is a pretty fast take-up in the scheme of things, then.

CHAIR: Less than 25 per cent?

Senator LUNDY: In the time frame. Sorry; you can speak for yourselves.

CHAIR: But you still have only one in four hooking onto it. Sorry; Senator Peris, continue.

Senator PERIS: Are you able to provide me with the premises and communities that are actually connected to those platforms?

Mr Brown: The actual addresses and locations?

Senator PERIS: Or the suburbs.

Mr Brown: Yes, we can provide that. I will take that on notice.
