1. What is the current number of premises in the Australian Capital Territory that have been passed by NBN Co fibre?
2. What number of these sites would be considered greenfield sites? What number would be considered brownfield?
3. What number of these sites currently connected are households and what number are businesses or other entities?
4. How many premises in the Australian Capital Territory currently have active connections to NBN Co's fibre network?

**Answer:**

1. 15,541 as at 2 December 2013.
2. Greenfields = 1,061, Brownfields 14,480
3. NBN Co does not store information related to the purpose of the premises in our address management systems.
4. 7,390 (BF = 6,868, GF = 522)
