Senator Ludwig asked:

- a) How many ongoing staff left the department/agency from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification were these staff?
- b) How many non-ongoing staff left department/agency from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification were these staff?

Answer:

- a) From 7 September to 31 October 2013, 298 permanent staff left Australia Post, with the following classifications:

Administrative, Contract and IT (All Levels)	49
Customer Contact Centre (All Levels)	27
Postal Services (including Delivery Managers, Postal Delivery Officers, Postal Parcel Services Officer, Drivers, Sorters, Transport, Technical Services and Trainees, etc.)	147
Retail	75

Postal Services (including Delivery Managers, Postal Delivery Officers, Postal Parcel Services Officer, Drivers, Sorters, Transport, Technical Services and Trainees, etc.)	106
Retail	36
