Topic: Staffing recruitment

Senator Ludwig asked:

- a) How many ongoing staff recruited from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- b) How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- c) From 7 September 2013 to date to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

- a) From 7 September 2013 to 31 October 2013, 140 permanent staff were recruited, with the following classifications:

Administrative, Contract and IT (All Levels)	23
Customer Contact Centre (All Levels)	76
Postal Services (Including Delivery Managers, Postal Delivery Officers, Postal/Parcel Services Officer, Drivers, Sorters, Transport, Technical Services, and Trainees, etc)	22
Retail	19
Total	140

- b) From 7 September 2013 to 31 October 2013, 125 fixed term positions have been created, with similar classifications to those listed above.
- c) From 7 September 2013 to 31 October 2013, 21 staff have been employed on contract and their average length of employment has been 1.1 months.
