Dear Senator McEwen

On 27 May 2009 I appeared as a witness before the Senate Standing Committee on Environment, Communications and the Arts for the Budget Estimates Hearing.

During the hearing, Senator Birmingham asked a question which appears on ECA 40. In response to that question I indicated that AFTRS was not registered as a CRICOS provider and that CRICOS was the international student provider.

I wish to advise that CRICOS is the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students. Registration with CRICOS is required to allow institutions to offer courses to international students. CRICOS itself is not an international student provider.

It would be appreciated if you could please inform all committee members of this correction.
