Dear Senator McEwen

Following Budget Estimates in May 2009, Senator Birmingham, in his capacity as a member of the Senate Standing Committee of the Environment, Communications and the Arts, asked the Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts the following written question (Question number 230).

- 1. What is the Department's hospitality spend for 2008/09? Please detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events.
- 2. For each Minister/Parliamentary Secretary's office, please detail total hospitality spend for 2008-09. Please detail date, location, purpose and cost of each event.

In October 2009 a response was submitted to the Committee. When preparing subsequent responses to similar questions asked by Senator Birmingham we have been made aware of some minor errors in our original response.

The total hospitality spend for the Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts for 2008/09 has been revised from \$159,017.98 to \$171,328.51. Details of official hospitality provided by Senator Wong while in Beijing in relation to her Climate Change portfolio responsibilities was inadvertently included in our response and has been removed.
