Senator MACDONALD asked: I appreciate you have to moderate the panels. Is there any reason why you could not let us have the assessments of each panel for all of the projects? While you are taking that on notice, I would like to ask the same question in relation to the big grants, which the scientific panel gave a ranking to. Are we able to get the list of projects that got to them and how they ranked them?

Answer

The assessment of all proposals received in response to the 2009-10 Caring for our Country business plan was coordinated by the Australian Government Land and Coasts Team. All proposals were assessed against the assessment criteria published in the 2009-10 business plan.

Some proposal categories, including those for the National Reserve System and for regional base-level funding, required specialised advice. Reef Rescue investments were informed by a multi-criteria analysis process undertaken in consultation with Reef stakeholders and scientists.

Attachment A details the assessment outcomes for the competitive (including large-scale), Landcare, Reef Rescue, and World Heritage components of Caring for our Country. A score of 'A' by the Primary Assessment Panel indicates that the proposal "provides strong performance against targets, good public benefit, and represents good value for money", a score of 'B' indicates "competitive performance and cost but would need to improve delivery against targets", a score of 'C' indicates that proposals have "high relevance, but performance and cost may be prohibitive", and a score of 'D' indicates "unable to demonstrate good delivery against targets or value for money".

Final details of proposals relating to the National Reserve System are not yet available for release as contracts are still being finalised.

Senator COLBECK—I want to go back to the Caring for our Country stuff, particularly the application from NRM North for assistance to manage the Tasmanian lowland native grasslands that were declared by Minister Garrett earlier in the year. I just want to get some sense around the issues that were with that particular application and why it was not successful. The concern from the farmers was that the declaration was made one week with a recommendation from the minister to apply to Caring for our Country to support their requirements to manage those lands. Yet the following week the application that they had in for \$9 million was actually rejected.

Ms Rankin—Was this taken on notice yesterday; is that right?

Senator COLBECK—If my recollection is correct, the discussion we had yesterday—and I value the fact that you were taking note of what happened yesterday and not getting wires crossed; that is a good sign—was that there is a reserve list. If you want to take it on notice and apply it as part of the response that comes back through DAFF I am content with that, but I just want to put that issue on notice.

Ms Rankin—We are happy to do that. I do not want to give you inaccurate advice.

Answer:

Applications for funding under the 2009-10 Caring for our Country Business Plan were subject to an assessment by government officials, followed by independent assessments by a community advisory panel or a scientific assessment panel. Based on the outcomes of these assessment processes, a list of recommended projects that addressed the best mix of targets for funding under the Caring for our Country 2009-10 Business Plan was prepared for consideration by the Natural Heritage Ministerial Board. The Board reviewed the recommended projects and identified those for immediate funding, based on the available budget, and those to be placed on a reserve list should funds become available in future, for example, due to the withdrawal of approved projects. The NRM North proposal, *Integrated conservation of Tasmania's Lowland Grasslands* was not included in the final list of projects approved by the Board, or the reserve list.

Detailed feedback on any unsuccessful application will be provided to a proponent on request. All unsuccessful applicants were advised in writing how to obtain feedback on their unsuccessful proposal.

In recognition of the threat that foxes pose to native wildlife and agricultural enterprises in Tasmania, the Australian Government has provided over \$5 million to the Tasmanian Government's Fox Eradication Program since 2005. This includes \$980,000 in 2008-09 from the Caring for our Country program.

In 2009-10 an additional \$1 million from Caring for our Country has been approved to support the Tasmanian Government's Fox Eradication Program.

Earlier this year the Tasmanian Government commissioned an independent review of the Fox Eradication Program. The Australian Government is considering future funding for the Tasmanian Fox Program in light of the findings of that review

The department is currently mapping all 2008-09 projects against the Caring for our Country outcomes and targets, which sit beneath the national priorities. This mapping of investments to targets will facilitate consistent reporting on expenditure and progress each year.
2. No. Final data on the actual success rate of proposals developed under the 2009-10 Caring for our Country business plan will not be available until all funding decisions are approved. However, it is estimated that over 17 per cent of all proposals assessed under the 2009-10 business plan will be successful in whole or part.

Four projects in the Northern Territory were approved for funding under the competitive element of the 2009-10 Caring for our Country business plan in addition to the regional base-level funding offered to the Northern Territory regional body. Three of these projects have commenced planning and have gained consent to work on Aboriginal land, however, the fourth project, aiming to eradicate ship rats from Truant Island, will not proceed because traditional owner consent was not forthcoming.

For the delivery of projects funded by regional base-level funding, the Northern Territory Natural Resource Management Board Inc is working with community based organisations to implement projects and has consulted with relevant traditional owners and land councils during the development of the funding submission and during contract negotiations.

2. The Government is committed to continuous improvement, transparency and accountability, and to this end the business plan and application process have been extensively reviewed and redesigned, taking into account stakeholder feedback. Consultations with key stakeholders (including state and territory governments, regional natural resource management organisations, non-government organisations, indigenous and community groups) and responses to an on-line survey have resulted in a review of targets for the 2010-11 business plan and a more streamlined application process. In May 2009 the Department released a Caring for our Country Monitoring, Evaluation, Reporting and Improvement (MERI) Strategy which supports Australian Government requirements for accountability and transparency in the expenditure of public funds through reporting by outcomes. A Caring for our Country report card will be available shortly to report on investments and achievements. A report card will be issued annually

Answers:

1. A range of sediment management, nutrient management, pesticide management and enabling technologies have been implemented through Reef Rescue's Water Quality Grants and Partnerships, examples of the specific practices are outlined below. Most practices, while focused on reducing a particular pollutant will have multiple benefits including in most cases an improvement in farm productivity.

Sediment management

- Farmers are reducing sediment run-off through:
 - moving to lower tillage practices
 - adopting mulching (e.g. green cane trash blanketing in cane)
 - installing tail water/runoff detention ponds
 - contouring their paddocks and drainage systems to slow water run-off
 - rehabilitating riparian buffers to adsorb run-off
 - avoiding bare ground fallows
 - monitoring and managing ground cover
 - rehabilitating degraded land including through fencing to land type and to permit rotational grazing and wet season spelling of paddocks

Nutrient management

- Farmers are moving to:
 - precisely match the nutrient requirements of their crops with the amount of fertiliser they apply
 - undertake soil and leaf testing and calculating a nutrient budget (including all sources and sinks of nutrients - e.g. nitrogen from legumes planted, taken off in crops harvested).
 - adapt machinery to precisely apply variable rates of fertiliser across paddocks to match the calculated crop requirements and to apply the fertiliser below the surface to prevent it being washed off.
 - manage their irrigation systems (e.g. scheduling, methods etc) to reduce pathways for nutrient loss (e.g. leaching of nutrients to groundwater).
 - fence riparian areas and install off-stream watering points to keep cattle out of waterways.

Pesticide management

- Farmers are being encouraged to more safely and efficiently use pesticides and adapt machinery (e.g hooded sprayers) to improve accuracy and efficiency of pesticide application and;
 - use alternative weed control methods, such as mulching and non-residual herbicides.

Enabling technologies

- Adopt GPS technology on farm machinery and GPS base stations technology for precision agriculture that includes variable rate fertiliser application and controlled traffic (using set wheel spacing and defined furrows to minimise compaction of paddocks) and;
 - complete property management plans and risk assessments, and to access technical advice, to help them identify risks to water quality and integrate soil, nutrient and chemical management with priority on-ground works
2. As at 6 October 2009 \$107.84 million of the \$200 million has been committed and of this \$40.53 million has been expended (\$29.8 million in 2008-09 and \$10.73 million in 2009-10). The commitments include:
- a. \$29.8 million in 2008-09
 - b. \$50.49 million each year over 3 years for water quality grants and partnerships
 - c. \$3.35 million each year over 2 years for Indigenous Land and Sea Partnerships program
 - d. up to \$9 million each year over 4 years for Research and Development program
 - e. \$15.2 million each year over 4 years for Reef Rescue Integrated Paddock to Reef Monitoring program.

Senator BIRMINGHAM asked:

1. Why has funding for Waterwatch not been allocated through the Caring for our Country program?
2. Have any Waterwatch officers lost their jobs as a result of Catchment Management Authorities not being able to sustain the program since funding was cut?

Answers:

1. Applications for Caring for our Country funding were invited from proponents where they could demonstrate the capacity to undertake work which will achieve targets and outcomes that address national priorities as identified in the Caring for our Country 2009-10 business plan. A large number of high-quality applications were received in response to the Caring for our Country 2009-10 business plan call for investment proposals. All proposals were assessed on their merit but, because of the high demand, many good quality proposals were unsuccessful. There were three Waterwatch specific proposals received in response to the 2009-10 business plan. None were successful.

Waterwatch activities, which include water quality monitoring, environmental education and riparian restoration activities, may also be supported by regional NRM organisations through their base level funding under Caring for our Country.

Community groups such as Waterwatch are encouraged to discuss local grant options with regional NRM organisations or identify other groups with whom they could form partnerships to submit an investment proposal. In addition, the \$5 million Community Action Grants program was announced this year, under which eligible community groups who did not receive funding under the 2009-10 business plan could apply for grants of between \$5,000 and \$20,000 to take action to protect Australia's environment. To be eligible, groups need to have as their principal objective the protection or enhancement of the natural environment, sustainable farming or land management. Applications closed on 22 October 2009 and successful proposals will be announced soon.
2. Waterwatch is highly decentralised with the name, priorities and organisational structure varying greatly across jurisdictions and between regional NRM organisations. The Australian Government has not directly employed officers in state- or regionally-based waterwatch programs and is therefore unable to provide this data.

Senator BIRMINGHAM asked:

1. Why has Land and Water Management Plan funding not been prioritised within Caring for Our Country despite achieving significant outcomes?
2. What percentage of funding has gone to Catchment Management Authorities compared to grass-roots community groups?

Answers:

1. The targets selected for Caring for our Country investment reflect the Australian Government's consideration of the most critical national sustainable management and environmental priorities. Elements of land and water management plans could receive Caring for our Country funding where they contribute to current investment targets.
2. Funds are provided to regional Natural Resource Management (NRM) organisations, in some states known as Catchment Management Authorities, and grass-roots community groups as well as various other stakeholders to achieve defined outcomes and targets through a number of avenues.

\$138 million (34 per cent) from the 2009-10 budget has been provided as base level funding for regional Natural Resource Management organisations and the investment of these funds was approved through the 2009-10 Business Plan process. Most regional NRM organisations provide a proportion of their base level funding to grass roots community groups through devolved grants and other mechanisms.

Regional NRM organisations have also been successful in applying for additional funds through competitive funding in the 2009-10 business plan (17 per cent of 2009-10 funds approved through the business plan). Some of the competitive funding approved for regional Natural Resource Management organisations will also benefit grass-roots community groups where regional organisations run devolved grants programs or where approved investment involves partnerships with grass-roots community groups.

Funding that has been approved to go directly to grass-roots community groups through the 2009-10 business plan is \$13.004 million in 2009-10 (7 per cent) and \$29.5 million through to 2012-13 (also 7 per cent).

A summary table is provided showing the proportion of funds approved as at the end of September 2009 under the 2009-10 business plan for regional base level, regional competitive, and grass roots community groups. As explained, this does not show the funds distributed to community groups by regions.

Additional funding for grass roots community groups will be provided in 2009-10 under Caring for our Country through programs such as the Community Action Grants, Working on Country, Indigenous Protected Areas, Landcare and Environmental Stewardship.

Senator SIEWERT asked:

1. How many NRM sub-regions have no active NRM projects (as opposed to facilitators) as a result of CFOC?
2. How many funded projects (and what amount of money) addressed essentially only one asset or threat?
3. How many projects addressing multiple targets in priority regions were not funded but were supported by the assessment panels?
4. What is the strategy to retain community commitment and support capacity in sub-regions with no active projects under CFOC?
5. Is it true that these grants are generally an effective rural investment with multiplier effects in rural economies? What is the likely impact of effective disinvestment in several rural NRM sub-regions?

Answer

1. In some natural resource management regions, there are particular community groups that work closely with the regional organisations, and may call themselves sub-regions. The Australian Government does not categorise community organisations as sub-regions and does not have a register of groups that operate as such.
2. Under Caring for our Country, proposals are assessed against their contribution to the Caring for our Country targets rather than to a specific number of assets or threats. If a proposal contributes to a single target, it does not necessarily follow that it will only address a single asset or threat.
3. All proposals were initially assessed using the merit assessment tool. This process provided an overall assessment of merit without any reference to the available budget. As a result, the list of proposals initially found suitable for funding vastly exceeded the available funds. The final recommendations of the Executive Panel, which consolidated and refined the advice developed at earlier stages of the assessment process, were accepted by Ministers.

4. The Australian Government recognises that community groups have specific requirements that need to be addressed to enable them to participate effectively in Caring for our Country. To boost local community participation, the government has introduced the \$5 million Community Action Grants component of Caring for our Country. Grants of between \$5 000 to \$20 000 will be provided directly to Landcare, Coastcare, Indigenous, environmental and community groups for activities such as tree planting, revegetation, dune rehabilitation and field days. 673 proposals from community groups are currently being assessed and successful proponents are expected to be advised in December 2009. The government will continue to monitor the effectiveness of approaches to community participation in Caring for our Country.
5. Overall, it can be expected that regional investments will benefit regional economies, although no recent analysis of the specific multiplier effects of these investments, or of any change in the focus of investment, has been undertaken by the Department. A wide range of community groups, including those identifying as 'sub-regions', have received investment under Caring for our Country. These groups will continue to be provided with opportunities to apply directly for funding under the business plan and community action grants processes. Successful applicants will continue to be those who can demonstrate that they can deliver the most cost-effective and efficient delivery of Caring for our Country targets. Community groups are also encouraged to work with their local regional NRM organisation to participate in delivery of NRM outcomes using regional base-level funding.
