

I refer to the hearing of the Environment, Communications, Information Technology and the Arts Legislation Committee held on 20 November 2002.

In responding to questions from Senator Lundy regarding the *Support Your Sport* initiative of the Australian Sports Commission [Hansard page ECITA 104], I inadvertently mixed the financial contributions from our program partners. The correct responses are as follows:

Senator Lundy: - How much in kind or cash did they put in?

Mr Peters – Reebok have put in around \$650,000 in apparel and in kind, but I can clarify that for you.

Senator Lundy – How much did Westfield put in?

Mr Peters – They have put in around \$2 million, including marketing and promotional campaigns.

I would be grateful if these amendments could be made to the Hansard record of the hearing.
