### Senator ABETZ asked:

1. Mr Graeme Samuel, as ACCC chairman, you have been actively lobbying for criminal penalties for proven cartel behaviour. What is your understanding of the level of proof required in a criminal prosecution versus a civil prosecution?

#### **Answer:**

Criminal prosecutions require proof beyond reasonable doubt as opposed to the balance of probabilities in civil matters.
