ANSWER

a. What is their budget?

The Enterprise Connect program has a single appropriation and all services and assistance are managed within that single appropriation. There are no specified allocations for each service or assistance element.

The appropriation for the Enterprise Connect program since commencement is as follows. From 2010-11 on the program has an ongoing allocation of \$50.8 million per year.

c. Does the program operate independently of other programs?

The Enterprise Connect program operates independently of other programs, however, Enterprise Connect works closely with other AusIndustry, State Government and Federal Government programs to encourage cross referral of clients between programs.

d. Where are the programs located?

All services and assistance offered by Enterprise Connect are delivered through the national network of Centres.

e. Is there any sharing of staff, offices, IT or administration with any other program, is so, provide details?

Enterprise Connect does not share staff or accommodation with other programs. The Department provides IT support to all divisions through its E-Business Division and administrative assistance through its Corporate Division.

f. Is there any overlap/commonality between users of the services provided by each of the Business Enterprise Centres, Enterprise Connect, AusIndustry and the Industry capability Network and Supplier Access to Major Projects Program?

The listed programs/entities have different, and complementary, functions and objectives. There may be companies that access different programs and/or services available through Business Enterprise Centres, Enterprise Connect, AusIndustry and the Industry Capability Network. The Supplier Access to Major Projects program does not fund companies. It funds existing networks, predominantly the state industry Capability Network offices, to connect Australian companies with major project supply opportunities.
