### Senators BARNETT & EGGLESTON asked:

- 1. How many permanent staff have been recruited since the supplementary budget estimates?
- 2. What level are these staff?
- 3. How many temporary positions and temporary employees exist or have been created/employed since supplementary budget estimates?
- 4. Since supplementary budget estimates, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

## Handling instructions:

The date used for the figures for supplementary budget estimates is 25 October 2009. The end date for figures is 8 February 2010.

*Note the addition of the wording 'temporary employees' in question 3.* 

The terms staff/employees refers to people employed under the Public Service Act.

#### **Answer:**

- 1. Between 25 October 2009 and 8 February 2010, 111 permanent staff were recruited.
- 2. The levels of these staff are provided in the following table:

3. As at 8 February 2010, there were 1,998 non-ongoing employees in the ATO.

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4. For the period 25 October 2009 to 8 February 2010, 314 new non-ongoing employees were engaged in the ATO. The average length of their employment was 357 days.
