The Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Research commissioned Colmar Brunton Social Research Pty Ltd to conduct a survey of small business from 25 May 2010 to 30 August 2010 for \$76,400 (inclusive of GST). The survey cost exclusive of GST was \$69,455.

This research surveyed small businesses as part of an internal departmental review of the Small Business Support Line.

The results have not been released publicly as the research was commissioned to form part of a routine internal review process.
