How many days' worth of work did Steve Bracks undertake for the Government in 2010, and how much was he paid? What were his travel costs?

ANSWER

In 2010, the Hon Steve Bracks AC undertook 12 days and three hours work for the Government in his role as Automotive Envoy. For this work he was paid \$12,375 (GST exclusive). His travel related costs were \$21,585.02 (GST exclusive).
