Have there been any other government roles (aside from being Chief Scientist) for which Professor Chubb has been financially remunerated since November 2007? If so, which position(s)?

**ANSWER**

Professor Chubb was financially remunerated for his participation as a member of the CSIRO Board. He was appointed on 7 August 2008 and resigned with effect from 8 December 2011. He declined remuneration for this position with effect from the date of his appointment as Chief Scientist for Australia.
