ANSWER

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, INNOVATION, SCIENCE, RESEARCH AND TERTIARY EDUCATION

The department has engaged 34 graduates this year. The graduates have been placed in the following divisions throughout the department:

The graduates will undertake a Certificate IV in Government as the training component of the Graduate Development Program. This training will be delivered by McMillan Staff Development who is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO). The total cost of the training program is \$170,000.

**AUSTRALIAN NUCLEAR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ORGANISATION
(ANSTO)**

1. Nil this year. ANSTO graduates are engaged every two years, the last intake (2011) was 24 positions.
2. Existing graduates are placed across the multiple research institutes and other facilities on the ANSTO site at Lucas Heights NSW.
3. The graduates each work in three different areas of ANSTO during the two year program to ensure they are exposed to different aspects of the organisation that match their skills. Training for graduates is individually customised by the Division within ANSTO to which they are assigned. All of the graduates participate in a two week development course that utilises internal and external trainers, the total cost of that course was \$12,977. External trainers engaged for this program were the Australian Institute of Management, Be Learning, Real Changes and Brainpower Training.

Please note – as this information is as at 29 February 2012 this does not include Outcome 3 and associated Agencies which is transferring from the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations due to the recent Machinery of Government.
