AUSTRALIAN RESEARCH COUNCIL (ARC)

Support is provided for employees to undertake courses of study that will contribute to the improvement of their professional skills and knowledge relevant to their employment.

So far in the 2011-2012 financial year, the ARC has spent approximately \$6,000 on four employees studying for a Bachelor degree and two employees studying for a Masters degree.

Staff are entitled to up to 8 hours study leave per week however each application is assessed on its merit.

Given the numbers involved there is a potential for the release of personal information and so the ARC is unable to disaggregate further.

COMMONWEALTH SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATION (CSIRO)

CSIRO spent \$5.1 million on external training and conferences (excluding travel) for the period 1 July 2011 to 29 February 2012.

Detailed information pertaining to the types of courses, costs and participants is not available centrally. A manual check of our records at all of CSIRO's sites for the specified period would be required to provide this information. The Organisation can obtain the information at this level of detail however it would involve a very significant application of the Organisation's resources which mitigate against providing the level of detail sought.
