How much in total has been spent each year on the Automotive Supply Chain Development Program? How much remains allocated to that scheme over each of the remaining years of the program?

ANSWER

The Department was allocated \$3,970,000 of administered Automotive Supply Chain Development Program funding for 2009-10 and spent \$3,932,500.

The Department was allocated \$5,420,000 of administered Automotive Supply Chain Development Program funding for 2010-11 and spent \$5,287,150.

The Department was allocated \$5,420,000 of administered Automotive Supply Chain Development Program funding for 2011-12 and spent \$3,006,559 as at 5 March 2012. A further \$2,393,439 has been committed.

The Department was allocated \$4,688,000 of administered Automotive Supply Chain Development Program funding for 2012-13 and has committed \$4,668,000.
