AusIndustry did not provide any promotional information or material about carbon pricing for Wodonga Council to publish in its quarterly newsletter dated October 2011. AusIndustry has confirmed that Wodonga Council reproduced information available on the Government's Clean Energy Future web site at that time. Wodonga Council did not seek approval to include AusIndustry contact details in the article.
