In the event that ASQA requires an applicant make amendments to its application, what time limits are involved for those amendments to be made, and are any time limits restarted in the event that ASQA requires further amendments?

ANSWER

If ASQA receives an incomplete application for registration – initial or to renew – it will seek further information from the applicant. There are no time limits imposed upon the applicant in relation to addressing those sections of their application that are incomplete.
