Topic: Lost superannuation – number of accounts

Senator SHERRY: Related to this, could the ATO—and I expect you to take this on notice—give a breakdown by value of \$1,000 the number of accounts in the lost, unclaimed category? We have five million accounts; how many have a value of less than \$1,000? How many have a value between \$1,000 and \$2,000? In categories of \$1,000 I am interested to see where the concentration is with lost accounts. **Mr Peterson:** We can do that breakdown for you. I have some of it now but not by \$1,000 and it would be a very boring conversation.

Senator SHERRY: Take it on notice.

Mr Peterson: It will be a very long list if they are broken down in groups of \$1,000.

Senator SHERRY: Let me change that. Five hundred dollars or less; \$500 to \$1,000 and then—what? Lots of \$5,000?

Mr Peterson: Yes, we can go up to \$500, then up to \$1,000 then say \$1,500 and we will go from there, if you like.

Senator SHERRY: Yes, okay. If you can do it that way. Just take it on notice; I do not need the information today.

Could the ATO give a breakdown by value of the number of accounts on the lost members register?
