Senator BUSHBY asked:

986. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis in 2007-08, 2008-09, 2009-10 and 2010-11? Provide a breakdown of each business group in each department/agency.
987. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis this financial year to date? Provide a breakdown of each business group in each department/agency.

Answer:

986. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) records taxi costs as part of Domestic Local Transport costs. Costs over recent financial years are summarised as follows:

FY 2007-08: \$ 347,886
FY 2008-09: \$ 263,389
FY 2009-10: \$ 274,943
FY 2010-11: \$ 262,909

987. The cost of Domestic Local Transport for the current financial year as of 31 January YTD is \$127,691.
