Senator LUDWIG asked:

- 1048) What is the arrangement with diners club for provision of credit cards for the Whole of Government Travel arrangements?
- 1049) What is the cost of using diners club to the government, listed by government and agency in fees and other charges?
- 1050) What are the criteria for staff receiving credit cards? Does the criteria vary between SES and other levels; do they require pre approval for certain classes of expenses?
- 1051) Please detail the limits of the credit cards issued to departmental staff; the types of cards; the card issuers;
- 1052) Have any credit cards been issued to ministers or ministers staff?

Answer:

- 1048) The ATO, under the Whole of Australian Government Travel Arrangements, uses a single virtual (CTS / Ghost) card for all transactions that are travel related. The arrangement is specified by a Deed that is managed by the Department of Finance. ATO staff do not receive Diners Club cards-in-hand.
