Answer:

- 105. The Treasury owns two cars.
 - a) The cars are located in New Delhi, India and Beijing, China
 - b) The cars are used for official business and personal use.
 - c) The running costs for the car in Beijing from 1 November 2013 to 28 February 2014 was \$3,483 (this includes insurance costs). The running costs for the car in New Delhi from 1 November 2013 to 28 February 2014 was \$561.78.
 - d) The distance the Beijing car travelled for this period is 4,427 km and the total distance the New Delhi car travelled is 3,328 km.
- 106. The Treasury lease three cars.
 - a) The cars are located in Canberra at the Treasury Building.
 - b) The cars are used for official business
- 107. The approximate running costs for the cars are as follows:
