### Senator LUDWIG asked:

- 190. What is the arrangement with diners club for provision of credit cards for the Whole of Government Travel arrangements?
- 191. What is the cost of using diners club to the government, listed by government and agency in fees and other charges?
- 192. What are the criteria for staff receiving credit cards? Does the criteria vary between SES and other levels; do they require pre approval for certain classes of expenses?
- 193. Please detail the limits of the credit cards issued to departmental staff; the types of cards; the card issuers;
- 194. Have any credit cards been issued to ministers or Ministers staff?

#### Answer:

- 190. The Whole of Government travel arrangements are managed by the Department of Finance (Finance). Any enquiries about how the travel card arrangement works should be directed to Finance.

- 192. Credit Cards are issued to staff if there is a work requirement for one. Expenditure on credit cards must comply with the Chief Executive's Instructions.
- 193. Credit card limits depend on the work requirements. Treasury currently issue ANZ Visa cards.
