- 2067. Are drafts shown to the Minister or their office before Question Time?

  - b. How many versions of this information are shown to the minister or their office?
- 2068. Does the minister or their office make any contributions, edits or suggestions for departmental changes to this information?
  - a. If so, when does this occur?
  - b. What officer hours were spent on making these edits? Please break down the hours by officer APS classification.
- 2069. Provide each of the contents page of the Minister and representing Minister's Question Time folder prepared by the department for the week of 11 February 2014.

### **Answer:**

- 2065. One ACNC staff member is responsible for preparing Question Time Briefs.
