2863. The Royal Australian Mint leases:

120 x Samsung LS24MYKRBQ/XAA SyncMaster 2443BW 24in TFT LCD Monitor, 0.27mmPP, 1920x1200, 16:10 AR, 1000:1

120 x Dell O980SCI5650328160DRW Optiplex 980 SFF, Core i5-650 3.2GHz, 8GB RAM, 160GB HD, DVDRW

The buyout of asset under Lease Agreement cost is \$33,175.68.
