**Senator LUDWIG asked:**

522. Is electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide a list of what is provided across the department of agency, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

**Answer:**

522. Yes. The AOFM provides iPads, iPhones, laptops, encrypted USB drives and a USB modem to staff. The operating expenses on those devices are as below:
