Senator LUDWIG asked:

- 934) How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio from the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?
 - a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office
- 935) How much was spent on departmental stationary requirements from the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date.

Answer:

- 934) From 1 December 2013 to 28 February 2014, the ATO spent \$260 (excluding GST) on stationery for the Treasury Portfolio Ministers.
 - Personalised envelopes for the ATO to forward ministerial correspondence to constituents.
- 935) From 1 December 2013 to 28 February 2014, the ATO (including the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission, Australian Valuation Office, Australian Business Register and Tax Practitioners Board) has spent \$290,638 (excluding GST) on stationery.
