Senator LUDWIG asked:

- 98. How many ongoing staff recruited from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 99. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 100. From Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

98. Since 25 November 2013, 32 ongoing FTE have commenced at the Treasury. Of these, 29 were new graduate starters in February 2014. Classifications are below:

99. There were 14.3 non-ongoing staff at the Treasury at the start of March 2014. 4.7 FTE commenced since November 2013. Classifications are below:
