Senator LUDWIG asked:

- 981) How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
- 982) Did the Department/agency use external printing services for any print jobs since 7 September 2013?
- If so, what companies were used?
 - How were they selected?
 - What was the total cost of this printing?

Answer:

- 981) For the period 21 November 2013 to 28 February 2014, 36,331,640 individual items were sent to print at a cost of \$2,044,566.06. Of these items the main products were:

NAT0046 PAYG payment summary	\$266,200.00	4,500,000
NAT3092 TFN declaration	\$1,309,572	18,000,000

During the same period, all products were also published online.

- 982) All products were printed using external suppliers. These suppliers are members of the ATO's Printing, mail out and related services panel.
- a) For the period 7 September 2013 to 28 February 2014, nine vendors were contracted. The vendors were:
