Tax Concession Figures Of Registrations and Revenue¹

The table below shows registration data for the R&D Tax Concession for the income years 1998-99 to 2002-03 (as at 12 May 2004).

Notes:

- 1. AusIndustry can only provide information on reported expenditure at the registration stage. Actual claims, and hence revenue forgone is information that is held by the Australian Taxation Office.
- 2. Commencement of Backing Australia's Ability Package.
- 3. Registrations for 2002-03 income year are expected to continue in 2004-05.
- 4. Reported Expenditure reflects what registrants report they have spent on Research and Development activities against which they may claim the R&D Tax Concession.
