Senator Campbell asked about:

With reference to table 5.2 on page 63 of the 2005-06 PBS, can you give us a breakdown of the line item 'suppliers' and its various subgroups?

ANSWER

"Suppliers expenses" incorporates the cost of services provided by an external party. It does not include services provided by departmental employees or depreciation/amortisation costs. For example, these expenses may include contractor services, lease costs and consultants.

It is not possible to provide a detailed breakdown for forward budget years as the budget estimates are prepared by extrapolating prior years' expenses. The proportion of different expenses from the 2003-04 Audited Financial Statements are listed below.
