Senator Campbell asked about:

Over the period covered by Parliamentary question on notice number 1685 (2003 to 2006), can you provide the percentages of IP Australia's funding that come from appropriations, fees from Australian customers and fees from non-Australian customers?

ANSWER

The following table provides a breakdown of IP Australia's funding by appropriations and fees from Australian and non-Australian applicants. In relation to IP Australia's major revenue lines, the majority of patents fees are paid in relation to non-Australian applicants (some represented by Australian agents) while the majority of trade marks fees are paid in relation to Australian applicants.
