Which data are collected to ascertain whether a grant and its recipient can be deemed a success – is it feedback volunteered by the recipient, is it some sort of follow-up?

ANSWER

Projects are identified by state and regional offices. In making their selections, they take account of such factors as: level of success; profitability; export success; recognition through industry awards and other appropriate factors.
