Discussions were entered into on the 6 May 2009 regarding the possibility of new funding for biochar research subject to Ministerial approval which was subsequently granted on 21 May 2009.

Total funding for the project is \$1.4 million. This will be shared between CSIRO and its partners in the research (Department of Primary Industries NSW, University Western Australia) to allow a national initiative on biochar to be conducted, overseen and guided by CSIRO.
