QUESTION No.: BI-62

How many sites, and how much land, does the CSIRO currently own? And what is the value of these assets?

ANSWER

Number of sites owned ¹ by CSIRO:	35
Amount of land owned by CSIRO:	6,080 hectares
Written down value of these assets:	\$1.24b ²

Notes:

1. This includes properties where CSIRO holds freehold title or 99 year Crown Leases of land.
2. All values are as at 30 June 2008 which is the date of the last portfolio revaluation.
