Does the Department have any statistics about what percentage of all business expenditure on R&D in Australia is currently devoted to applied research and what percentage is devoted to pure research?

## **ANSWER**

The latest Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) survey of Business R&D, *Research and Experimental Development, Businesses, Australia, 2007-08*, (catalogue number 8104.0) shows the following percentages by type of research:

Applied research: 32.10 per cent. Pure basic research: 0.52 per cent.
