Department of Resources, Energy and Tourism

1. The Department's policy is to pay all accounts within 30 days of receipt of a valid tax invoice. The Department takes payment of invoices within 30 days of receipt of a valid tax invoice seriously and has taken steps to improve the percentage of invoices paid on time, aiming for over 90 per cent. At present 84.8 per cent of invoices are paid within 30 days, and 94.7 per cent are paid within 60 days.
2. Steps have been taken within the Department to improve the timeliness of payments. This includes additional training of staff, reminders about the importance of prompt payments and regular reporting to the Executive on performance.
3. No interest has been paid on accounts paid over 30 days this or for the previous financial year. Under Finance Circular 2008/10, interest is only payable on "*Contracts for procurements with a value of up to A\$1 million (GST inclusive) from a small business*", "*the contractor has issued a correctly rendered invoice for the interest*" and payment shall be "*from Departmental items*".

GA

1. Yes, in a majority of cases the 30 day payment terms are met. Those not met are either due to disputing payment/invoice with the supplier, or waiting for correct banking details from suppliers. Only two payments have not met the 30 day small business payment policy.
2. Yes, \$97.96 for 2009-10.
3. Rate as determined by the Australian Taxation Office and at time of payment the daily interest charge rate was 3%.

TA

1. Tourism Australia's accounting policy is to settle on 30 day terms. As such it is standard practice to pay with those terms.
2. Under the rare circumstances that a payment does not occur within the 30 day terms (due to an oversight or change in personnel responsible for handling the payments) the payment is generally made within terms (even after 30 days) based on discussions with suppliers upon follow-up.
3. If interest is to be paid, it would be paid in accordance with the relevant provisions of the contract in place with the supplier. The interest determination is never ad-hoc.
