Senator Barnett asked:

- 1. How many permanent staff recruited since additional estimates (8 Feb 2010)?
- 2. What level are these staff?
- 3. How many temporary positions exist or have been created since additional estimates?
- 4. Since additional estimates, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

- **1.** There have been 140 ongoing (permanent) staff commence over the period 8 February 2010 to 5 July 2010.
- **2.** The table below shows the different levels of ongoing (permanent) staff recruited for the period 8 February 2010 to 5 July 2010.

- **3.** As at 5 July 2010 there are 541 non-ongoing (temporary) staff contracts. Since 8 February 2010 up to and including 5 July 2010 there have been 372 non-ongoing staff contracts generated. Note that each contract represents a separate period of employment and does not necessarily represent a separate person, such that the same person could be employed on a number of contracts during this period of time.
- **4.** Since 8 February 2010 and up to and including 5 July 2010 there have been 372 non-ongoing (temporary) staff contracts generated. The average length of contract is 76 calendar days.
