ANSWER

- 1. Yes. Advice and assistance has been sought on occasion from legal service providers, predominately the Australian Government Solicitor (AGS), to facilitate the processing of complex or protracted FOI requests. In addition, advice in the form of guidance notes is received from the Information Commissioner, AGS FOI training, Australian Public Service FOI working group and other like meetings/workshops.
- 2. 287* in the period 1 October 2010 to 31 May 2011.
- 3. 136 granted in full, 80 granted in part, 9 denied in full, 23 withdrawn, 1 transferred and 3 released outside FOI, 6 still in progress in the period 1 October 2010 to 31 May 2011.
