ANSWER

QUESTIONS 1 & 2:

The Department has contracted Australian Associated Press Pty Ltd (AAP) as the primary media monitoring service for the Department and the Ministers' Offices. The total cost for AAP Information Services to the Department and the Ministers' Offices for the 2010-11 financial year to date (1 July 2010 to 31 May 2011) is \$144,162 (GST exclusive).

For media transcripts the Department uses Media Monitors who provide transcript services to the Department and Ministers' Offices. The total cost to the Department and the Ministers' Offices for this service for the 2010-11 financial year to date (1 July 2010 to 31 May 2011) is \$37,199 (GST exclusive).
