Senator COLBECK: We will come to that in a sec—it is a good example for you to raise. How much, for example, did the space.gov.au website cost the department to build, and how many ASL are responsible for maintaining it on a daily basis?

Mr Pennifold: We will take it on notice. However, I would suggest with the space website, knowing a little bit about the construction of it, it was a rather simple site and the building of the site did not consume a lot of resources. The ongoing support of that site, again, is not a large component of my workload. But I will be able to provide you with some estimates.
