**Dr Nicoll:** There were commission papers. Papers come to the commission for decision.

Documentation and analysis would have come to the commission. I would need to take on notice what part of that we might be in a position to provide the committee.

**Senator MASON:** I am sure that the committee would appreciate anything that you can provide. I can understand the sensitivities with this. I am not blind to them. But if it is possible I would appreciate that.

**Senator Chris Evans:** It is best that Dr Nicoll takes it on notice and take some advice. As you know, it is highly controversial.
