Senator O'Brien asked about:

How much is the business events sector worth to Australia in terms of exports and domestic tourism?

## **ANSWER**

The most recent figures available are from research undertaken by the Sustainable Tourism CRC published in 'The National Business Events Study: An Evaluation of the Australian Business Events Sector'. This study found that in 2003, the overall estimated expenditure associated with business events in Australia was in excess of \$17 billion, direct contribution to value added was over \$6.1 billion and the direct contribution to employment was estimated to be 116,000 jobs. The international component of this was \$1.8 billion in direct expenditure, \$638 million in contribution to value added and the contribution to employment was over 17,000 jobs.
