Senator Campbell asked:

When will the Federal Government consult with state and territory governments about any proposed DDA Access to Premises Standard, what timelines are involved, and what form will that consultation take?

ANSWER

The Government intends to consult with State and Territory governments after it has had an opportunity to undertake more detailed analysis of the options and to consider its own position on the matter.

Section 132 (2) of the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 states:

Before making any regulations for the purposes of section 31 or 47, the Governor-General is to take into consideration any comments made to the Minister by a Minister of a State or Territory who is responsible for matters relating to disability discrimination.
