**QUESTION No.SI-44**

**Senator Carr** asked:

Is there any updated information relating to the estimated number of vehicles in each of the categories (LPG conversion, new LPG vehicles) that are expected to attract the subsidy in the years 2006-07 to 2013-14, as presented in table format in a letter dated 4 September 2006 from Mr Beeston to the Secretary of the Australia's Future Oil Supply and Alternative Transport Fuels Inquiry? If so, please provide details.

**ANSWER**

There is no updated information. The Department is closely monitoring demand.

**QUESTION No.SI-45**

**Senator Carr** asked:

How many persons annually apply for LGP conversion licences in different states and territories?

**ANSWER**

Responsibility for compliance and licensing rests with the States and Territories.

**QUESTION No.SI-46**

**Senator Carr** asked:

Since the *LPG Vehicle Scheme* was announced in August, how many applications have been received for the rebate to date, nationally and for each state and territory?

**ANSWER**

A total of 13,765 applications have been received as at COB Thursday 23 November 2006. We are currently unable to report on grants received by State. The Management Information System is being developed to provide a greater degree of reporting functionality.
