What is the Government doing with the findings and recommendations of the Accessible Housing Report which relate to the increasing and urgent problem of people wanting to remain in their homes and neighbourhoods but their housing is unsuitable for in-home support without expensive alterations?

**ANSWER**

The Accessible Housing report contains matters that are outside the ABCB's domain. The report is currently with the State and Territory Governments and the ABCB awaits their advice on the release of the report.
