**Senator RONALDSON**—Whom should I be asking about yields from business event tourists, yourselves or the department when they come back?

Mr Buckley—It comes out of our statistics, if you like.

**Senator RONALDSON**—What is the current yield from a business event tourist as opposed to a holiday tourist?

**Mr Buckley**—I do not have the numbers with me. I would need to come back to you with that breakdown.

Senator RONALDSON—Take it on notice.

## **Answer:**

For the year ending June 2008, the average total trip spend for visitors with the main purpose of visit for a conference/convention/exhibition was \$3180, \$3910 for incentive and corporate meetings visitors and \$4199 for leisure visitors (holiday and visiting friends and relatives). Business events visitors spent more per night than leisure visitors with average nightly expenditure of \$370, compared with \$179 for leisure visitors.
