QUESTION No.: SI-108

1. How much has been spent so far on the Commonwealth ANU Strategic Relationship – and what remains uncommitted?
2. What is the current number of participants in courses and activities conducted under the banner of the Australian National Institute for Public Policy?
3. How does that differ from the same figures one year ago?

ANSWER

1. To date, the Department of Innovation, has provided funding of \$72.25 million to ANU.
There is no uncommitted funding in relation to the Commonwealth-ANU strategic relationship.
2. 958 participants enrolled in courses conducted by the Australian National Institute for Public Policy (ANIPP).
3. 2011 was the first year courses were conducted by ANIPP.
