- 1. How much has been spent so far on the Commonwealth ANU Strategic Relationship and what remains uncommitted?
- 2. What is the current number of participants in courses and activities conducted under the banner of the Australian National Institute for Public Policy?
- 3. How does that differ from the same figures one year ago?

ANSWER

- 1. To date, the Department of Innovation, has provided funding of \$72.25 million to ANU. There is no uncommitted funding in relation to the Commonwealth-ANU strategic relationship.
- 2. 958 participants enrolled in courses conducted by the Australian National Institute for Public Policy (ANIPP).
- 3. 2011 was the first year courses were conducted by ANIPP.
